1. I am General Manager of Pacifica station KPFT in Houston, Texas.


2. On March 23, 2001, I and Molly O'Brien, the Director of Development at KPFT, were assaulted by a protester associated with an anti-Pacifica group. The attack occurred on the station's property, in front of the building from which KPFT is broadcast.

3. The protestor, Edwin Johnston, was arrested and charged with two counts of assault by the Houston Police Department.

4. Prior to the attack, Mr. Johnston and few other individuals had been distributing leaflets during an event at which KPFT had invited its donors, supporters, and listeners to the station. The protesters repeatedly trespassed upon the station's property, verbally harassed and threatened KPFT staff, and attempted to discourage donors from making contributions to Pacifica.

5. Mr. Johnston's co-protesters stood by and did nothing to stop Mr. Johnston's attack.

I declare under penalty of perjury under the laws of the State of California that the foregoing is true and correct and that this Declaration was executed on March 23, 2001, in Houston, Texas.
